

Copyright Terms of Use (License V001)

1. Definitions

- a. “Licensor” shall mean NASASpaceflight LLC
- b. “Partner” shall mean Astra Space Inc.
- c. **“TOU” shall refer to this Copyright Terms of Use (License V001).**
- d. “Broadcast” shall refer to the livestreamed broadcast of the ELaNa 41 launch
- e. “License” shall have refer to the grant of rights contained in Section 2, along with all limitations or restrictions thereto appended.

2. License

Subject to the restrictions contained herein, Licensor hereby grants you a limited nonexclusive, revocable, nontransferable, worldwide right and license to post, share, display, create derivative works of and publicly perform the Broadcast solely for non-commercial purposes. Such purposes shall expressly include i) translating the Broadcast to languages other than English, ii) providing good-faith commentary, discussion, or analysis to the Broadcast, iii) using the Broadcast as supplemental video in a manner secondary to primary footage (i.e, “b-roll” footage). Rebroadcasting the Broadcast without modification is expressly prohibited by this license. The rights and licenses granted herein shall not include the right for you to re-cut, edit, or modify the Broadcast, except for non-substantive or temporal modifications necessary to create highlights or cut downs as outlined herein.
